Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS THE GRAND SALE?

- The Grand Sale is a collaboration yard sale hosted by Sisters for Society Corporation.
- It will serve as a major fundraiser and raise awareness for our organization.

ARE THERE ANY FEES?

- Vendors are required to pay an entry fee of \$20.00 to participate and to submit a check in the amount of \$5.00 as a refundable security deposit.
- The fees must be submitted in two separate forms
- Checks and Money Orders should be made payable to: **SISTERS FOR SOCIETY CORPORATION**

DO I KEEP MY PROFITS?

- Yes, whatever you make from your sales is what you take.
- Sisters for Society Corporation does not require a split of profits; however, should your heart be led to make a donation to the organization, it will be greatly appreciated.
- Sisters for Society is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization, all donations are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. *Federal Tax ID #47-374524*

Rules and Regulations

- All applicants **MUST** complete an application.
- Under no circumstances will spaces be held without payment.
- All applicants must submit the entry fee payment in order to participate.
- Any vendor who has not paid by the deadline will lose their space.
- The Grand Sale is a rain or shine event. This means that applicants are pledging to attend the event rain or shine.
- Event hours are 8am to 4pm; vendors may arrive to set up at 7am and must be completed by 4:30pm.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tents, tables, extension cords, etc. *Vendors must secure extension cords for safety precautions.*
- Vendors are not permitted to share space.
- Vendors who require electricity must state so on the application.
- There is no vendor smoking permitted on premises.
- Booth placement will be issued to vendors in the form of a map, and will be sent to the vendors one week prior to the event. Booth assignments will be determined upon electricity requests. We will do our best to accommodate.
- Vendors are responsible for setup and clean-up of their spaces; ensuring all trash is disposed of properly.
- At the end of the event your area must be left clean. Vendors are responsible for collecting and properly bagging trash within your location. No trash from your booth may be left on the premises.
- Any vendor who leaves trash etc., will forfeit their deposit and will not be permitted to participate in future events.

Vendor space is limited; please submit application as soon as possible.

Terms & Conditions
